

Jeremy currently serves as Associate Pastor at Sanctuary Charlotte Church in Charlotte North Carolina and as Chaplain at Columbus Regional Healthcare System in Whiteville North Carolina. Jeremy is married to Jamila Simmons and they have three children, Jeremiah, Josiah and Jaila. Jeremy enjoys playing basketball, reading, and spending time with his family.
