In our text for this week, Romans 7:15-25a, Paul comments on his failure to overcome temptation and sin. But in admitting his weakness and failure, he challenges all of us to depend on Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of sins. Let us heed Paul's words as we declare our dependence on our Savior, Jesus Christ.

This is a great song to remind us to love God with our whole beings...not just as an intellectual pursuit or on Sunday mornings...but each and every day with all that we are.
