Sunday Worship: This week is the 2nd week in our sermon series, "Why Are We Here?" This series is exploring the six Great Ends of the Church found in our Book of Order. This week we will use Paul's words in Ephesians 4:1-16 to explore the 2nd Great End, "the shelter, nurture, and Christian fellowship of the children of God."

Hymn of the Month: Our Hymn of the month for September is a praise song from 1982. "Great Are You, Lord" was written by the husband and wife team, Michael W. Smith and Deborah Smith. Soon after Michael W. Smith recorded this song it became popular and has proven to be one of his most enduring songs.

"Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised" is a formulaic element in three psalms (48:1, 96:4, and 145:3). This recurring idea in this song encourages to praise God in response to His faithfulness, His power, His mercy, and His holiness. When we think of the qualities that we see exhibited in God's nature then we cannot help but proclaim that He is indeed worthy of our praise and worship.
