Sunday Worship: This Sunday will be week two in our sermon series, "Promises Kept". For the next several weeks we are exploring some of the Old Testament prophecies and how they were fulfilled in Jesus. My prayer is that by studying, and knowing, how the prophetic promises of old were kept we can better trust in God's promise of Jesus' return.

This week we will be exploring Isaiah 29:18-19. Our sermon title this week is, "Promises Kept: The Great Healer".

From the Pastor Congregational Meeting: Please remember that the Session has called a congregational meeting for this Sunday, January 20, for the purpose of acting on recommended changes to the pastor's terms of call. The meeting will begin following worship.

Extend the Hand of Fellowship: Most weeks we have a time of fellowship and greeting as part of the service. This is an exciting time to watch people connect and catch up. Let us be sure that everyone gets greeted and welcomed...not only by the ushers, but by those of us who have gathered for worship. My hope is that no one leave a service of worship here and feel they were overlooked...but it takes all of us to make that happen.

Martine Luther King, Jr. Community Worship Service: I invite you to join with your brothers and sister in Christ tomorrow for a service of worship that celebrates life and ministry of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. The service will be hosted Columbus Regional Hospital and will begin at 12:00. Light refreshments and a time of fellowship will follow the service.

Hymn of the Month: Our hymn of the month for January is "I Love You, Lord." This is a simple song of adoration that was written one day while the author's husband was away all day attending Central Oregon Community college. The author, Laurie Klein, found herself in their mobile home beside a highway to tend to their daughter. She describes the situation by saying, "With no friends, money, church home, or driver's license, the day I spent with our one-year-old seemed endless. My time with the Lord was not only my "life-line"—it was one of my rare opportunities to talk with someone "older"! One extra-lonely morning I found myself praying, "Lord, I want to worship you...I'm just so empty inside. Please give me something to sing that you would enjoy hearing." As I picked up my guitar, words and music came effortlessly.

As we sing this song notice how the strength of this text is that it resonates with a number of Biblical passages...Psalm 18:1, Isaiah 40:9, Psalm 103:1, Psalm 35:9, and Psalm 47:6. May this short little song enable us to truly open our hearts to God's presence and worship Him wherever we find ourselves.


