### "To be a light in our community reflecting Christ's love and compassion"

**Sunday Worship:** Continuing our sermon series, "Promises Kept" we turn to a rather familiar passage in Isaiah. Isaiah 52:13-16, 53:3-6 is known as the "Suffering Servant" passage. Here we read a description of what the servant of God will endure...on our behalf. I encourage you to read over these verses in preparation for Sunday. You may also want to read the following New Testament passages: Matthew 27:1-2, 15-23 and Acts 8:29-35.

From the Pastor Extend the Hand of Fellowship: Most weeks we have a time of fellowship and greeting as part of the service. This is an exciting time to watch people connect and catch up. I also want to encourage you to pay attention to those who may be seated near you...or perhaps across the sanctuary...that are visiting with us. Let us be sure that everyone gets greeted and welcomed...not only by the ushers, but by those of us who have gathered for worship. My hope is that no one leave a service of worship here and feel they were overlooked...but it takes all of us to make that happen.


