

The spring concert of the Southeastern Oratorio Society will be Monday, May 6, at 7:30 p.m. in our sanctuary. Musical selections in seven different languages are folk tunes from around the world - the U.S., South Korea, Greece, Germany, Israel, Ireland, Malaysia, and Africa. Familiar tunes include "The Gift To Be Simple," "Black Is The Color Of My True Love's Hair," "Ev'ry Time I Feel The Spirit," and "Danny Boy."

Southeastern Oratorio Society is a 45-year old community choir dedicated to singing the "world's great music and oratorios." It is composed of volunteers from several counties and two states. Seven of the singers this semester are members of FPC's congregation! The concert is free.
