Most people have a Bible! It may be beside your bed, favorite chair, or it could be sitting on your coffee table with family pictures and recipes tucked neatly within its covers. While 88% of people in the United States say they own a Bible...with each household having an average of 4.7 Bibles...studies show that only 37% of Americans read their Bible once a week or more. 
