



Sunday Worship: The last couple of weeks John the Baptist has been a fairly central role in our texts. This week our text focuses on a time much earlier...when Mary is found to be expecting a baby. We are oh so close to Christmas, but not quite there. So this week our Advent journey takes us to Matthew 1:18-25 and explores who Jesus really is...Emmanuel!

Christmas Eve Service: I hope that you will plan to join us for our annual Christmas Eve service at 5:00 p.m. in the sanctuary. This service will include the singing of many hymns, the last sermon in our Advent series "The Birth of Hope" as we examine the shepherds and the extraordinary message the angels brought to them. The service concludes with a beautiful candlelight service as we sing two powerful hymns, "Silent Night" and "Joy to the World". So, get your family together, invite your friends and neighbors, and join us Tuesday, December 24th, at 5:00 p.m.




