Community Outreach: Looking for some pretty simple ways to reach out to your community? Here are three ways that are easy, simple, but make a big difference!

- <u>Cards</u>: Write cards for employees at the hospital...or nursing home. You can drop these off at the church, there is a plastic shoe box beneath the carport of the Outback building, and we will deliver them for you. Jeremy Simmons, chaplain at the hospital, tells me every time I drop some off how much they mean to those who get them.
- <u>Snack Food</u>: Besides cards, I know the hospital welcomes donated snacks...homemade or store bought...for the staff. Just a little something that reminds them that they are in our thoughts and prayers. You can also drop these off at the church and we will deliver them.
- <u>Canned Food</u>: If you would like to help families in need within Columbus County, Community CPR is collecting canned food. There are collection boxes at Penn's Grill and Pharmacy on Main...or feel free to drop them off at the church and we will get them to where they need to be!

Face Masks: Last week wearing face masks in public became mandatory in NC. I will encourage you to please wear one as we work together to put this Covid-19 down. If you are in need of a face mask please contact me, or the office, as we have some homemade masks available. Donations are accepted.
