- 3. 1:30 In-person worship. This afternoon service, which we are offering on a trial basis for four weeks, requires masks throughout the whole service.

**Wednesday Prayer Service:** Each week we have been offering a Prayer Service using Zoom. This is a time when we can catch up with one another and then enter into a time of prayer together. We meet on Wednesdays at 6:30 and an invitation to join us is sent out either Monday or Tuesdays with a reminder going out about 6:00 p.m. on Wednesdays. This gathering and praying together typically lasts about 30 minutes. Hope you will join us

# **Sunday School Lessons:**

## Supplies needed:

Scissors, glue or tape, crayons

Instructions for the craft pack that will be delivered:

- 1. Color the disciples in the boat and Jesus if you want to. Draw some waves on the blue construction paper.
- 2. On blue construction paper, a slit 1/3 of the way up from the bottom that goes from about 2 inches from the right side to about 4 inches from the left side.
- 3. Cut Jesus out and glue him to the popsicle stick.
- 4. Cut the disciples out and glue them to the left upper side of the blue construction paper.
- 5. Put the popsicle stick with Jesus on it through the slit in the paper and from the back you can move Jesus back and forth...he is walking on water.
