- 2. 11:00 In-person worship. Please remember that this week we begin our new mask protocol for in-person worship: masks are required throughout the whole service.

Ash Wednesday: This coming Wednesday is Ash Wednesday and marks the beginning of Lent. I want to invite you to join us for our Ash Wednesday service at 6:00 in the sanctuary (with our current mask policy) and online on our normal streaming platforms. This is a joint service with Chadbourn Presbyterian Church and Westminster Presbyterian Church. The service will invite you to observe a holy season of Lent. Due to Covid-19 and necessary precautions to keep everyone safe we will not be including the imposition of ashes this year, though the focus of the service will remain the same. This is the first of three Lenten services that we do with these other two churches. We are planning that all of the services this year will be held here at FPC so we may livestream them.

Giving: There are three ways you can use to keep current with your church giving. If you attend in-person worship, there are collection plates at each entrance/exit. Online giving is an option, simply go to our webpage (www.fpcwhiteville.org) and follow the link to on-line giving. Or you can mail/drop off a check to the church office.

Sunday School: Be sure to check out our children's and youth Sunday School offerings! For the children there is a weekly video...the link is in this newsletter as well as the worship reminder email that goes out on Saturday evening. For the youth we have a list of Bible readings and questions. It is also included in this newsletter as well as the worship reminder email on Saturday!
